more eyes on the target

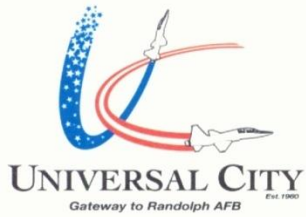
Involvement level is up to the participants

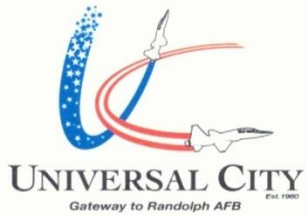

Pin outdoor hinges





Protect Car & Garage

Use garage

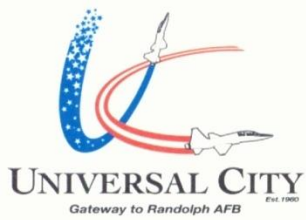
Trunk your Junk

Lock inside door



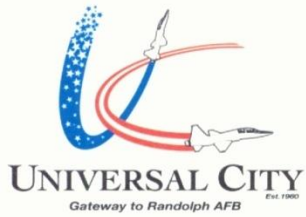


NEIGHBORHOODS

Suspicious Activities

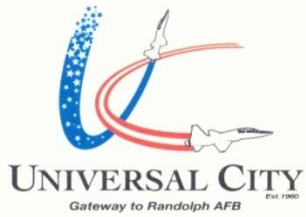
Open/broken doors or windows at closed business or unoccupied residence

Heavy traffic at a residence



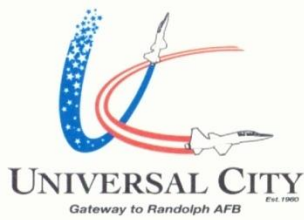


BLOCK CAPTAINS

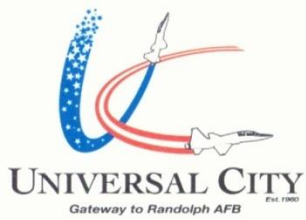
