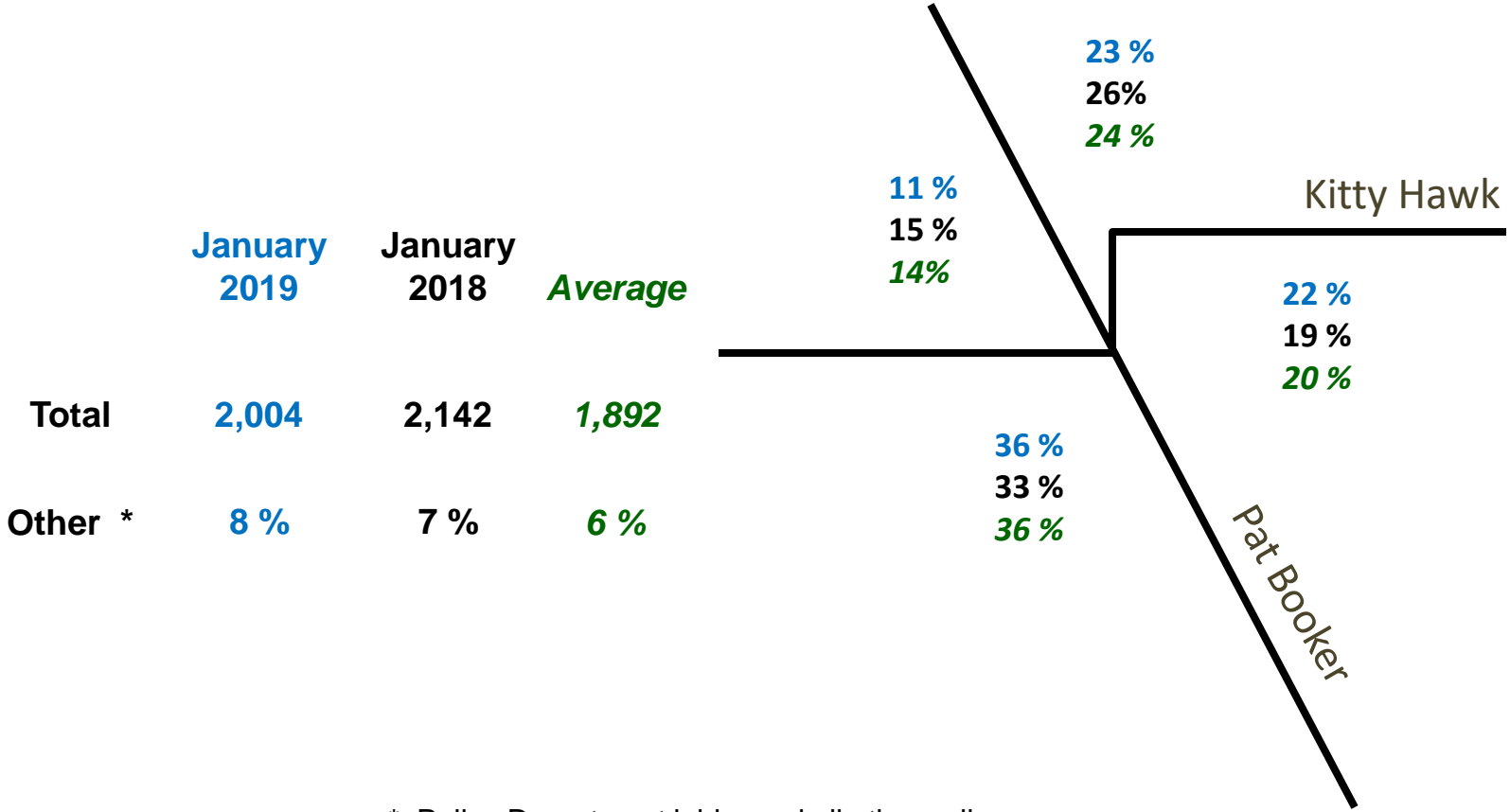

# Dispatches

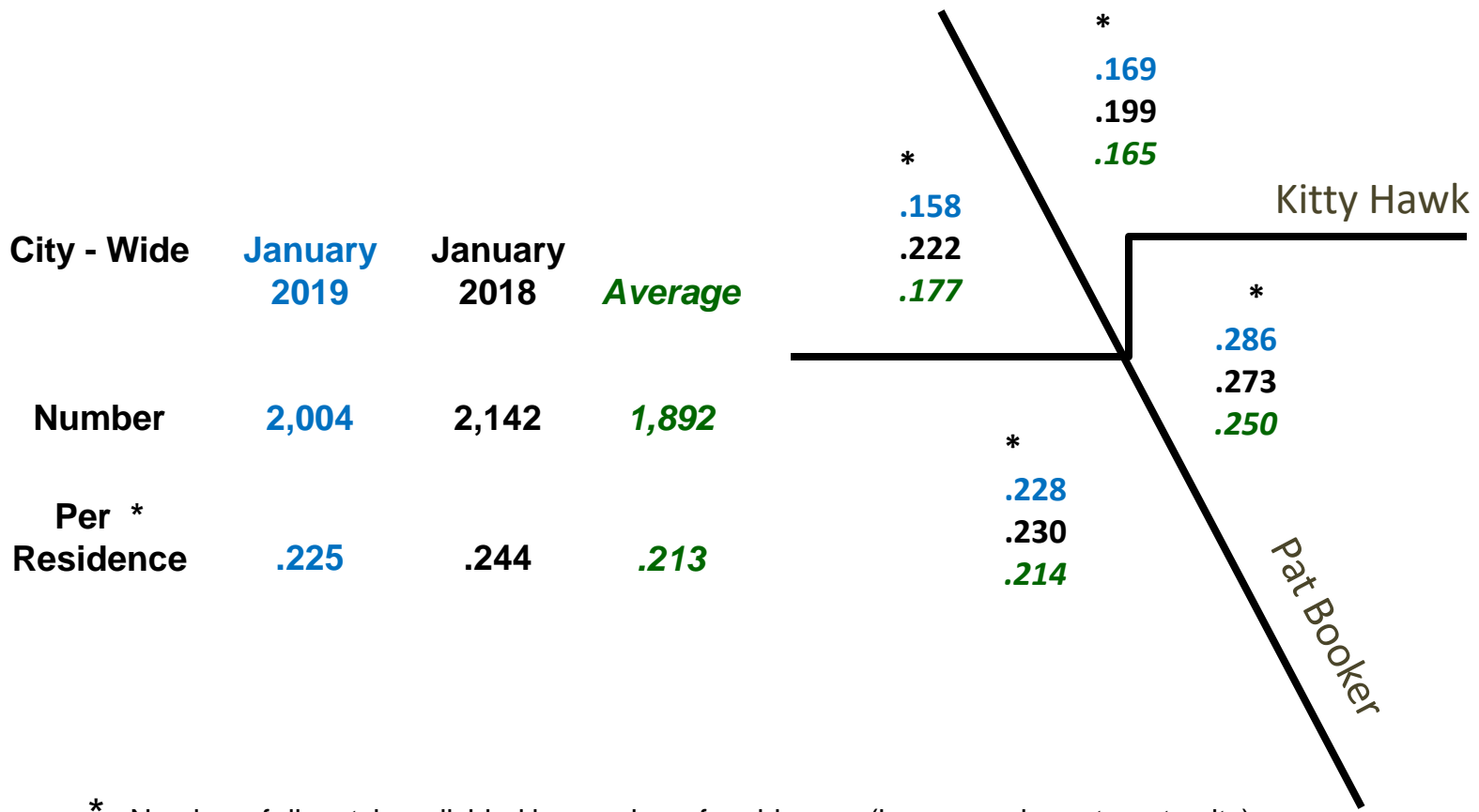
% by District

Examples of contacts without reports include, but are not limited to, false alarms, unfounded complaints and unable to locate.
