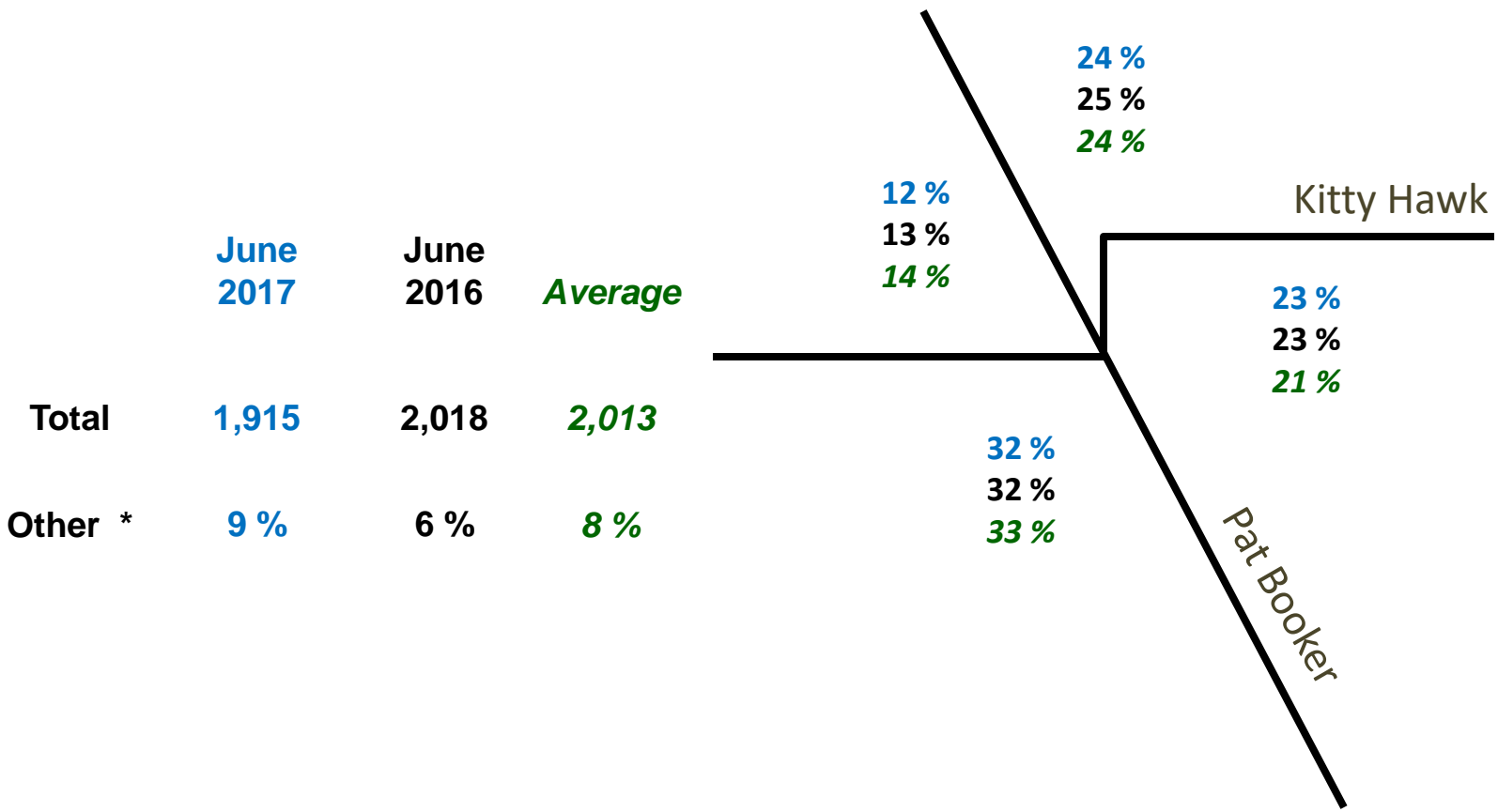

% by District

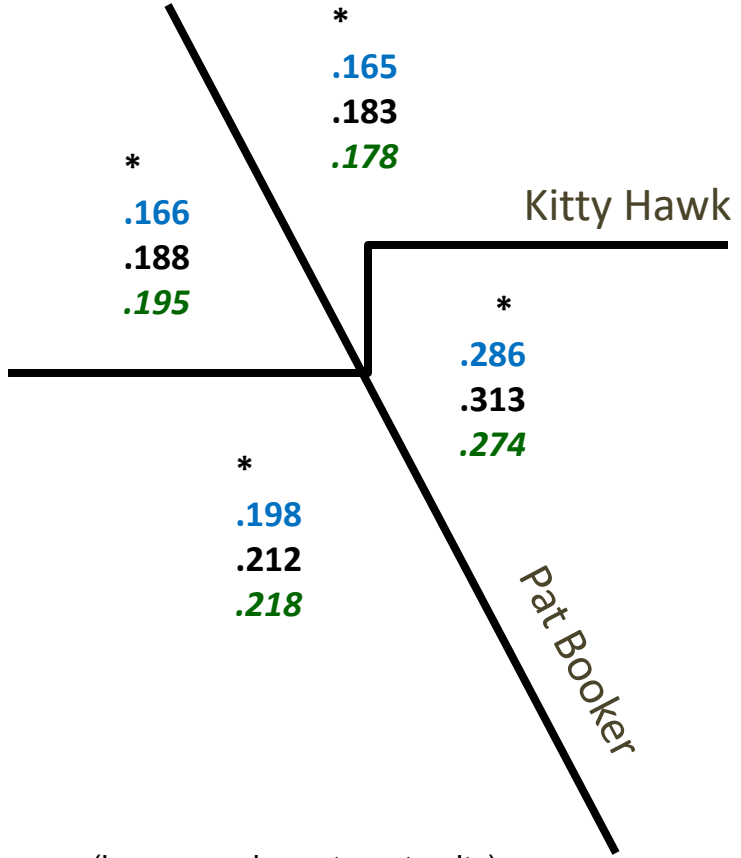

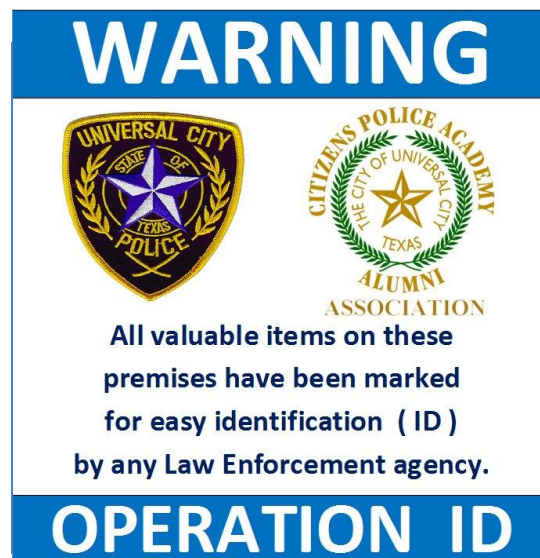
