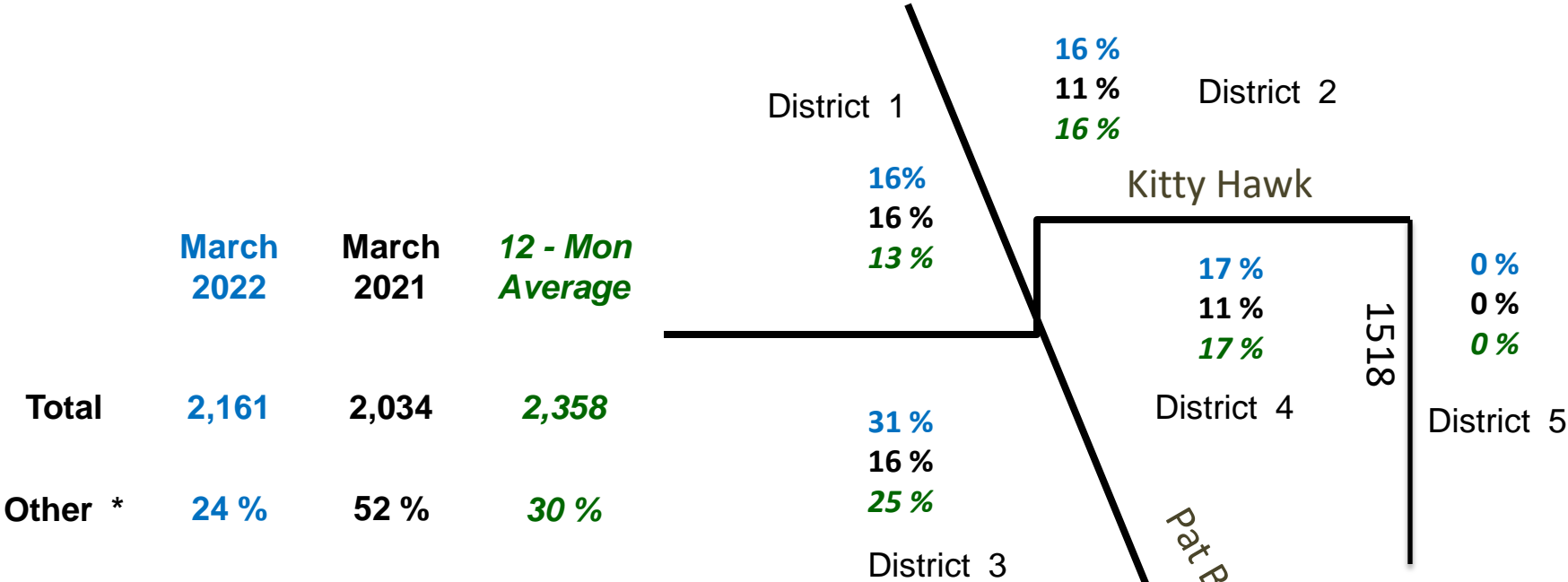

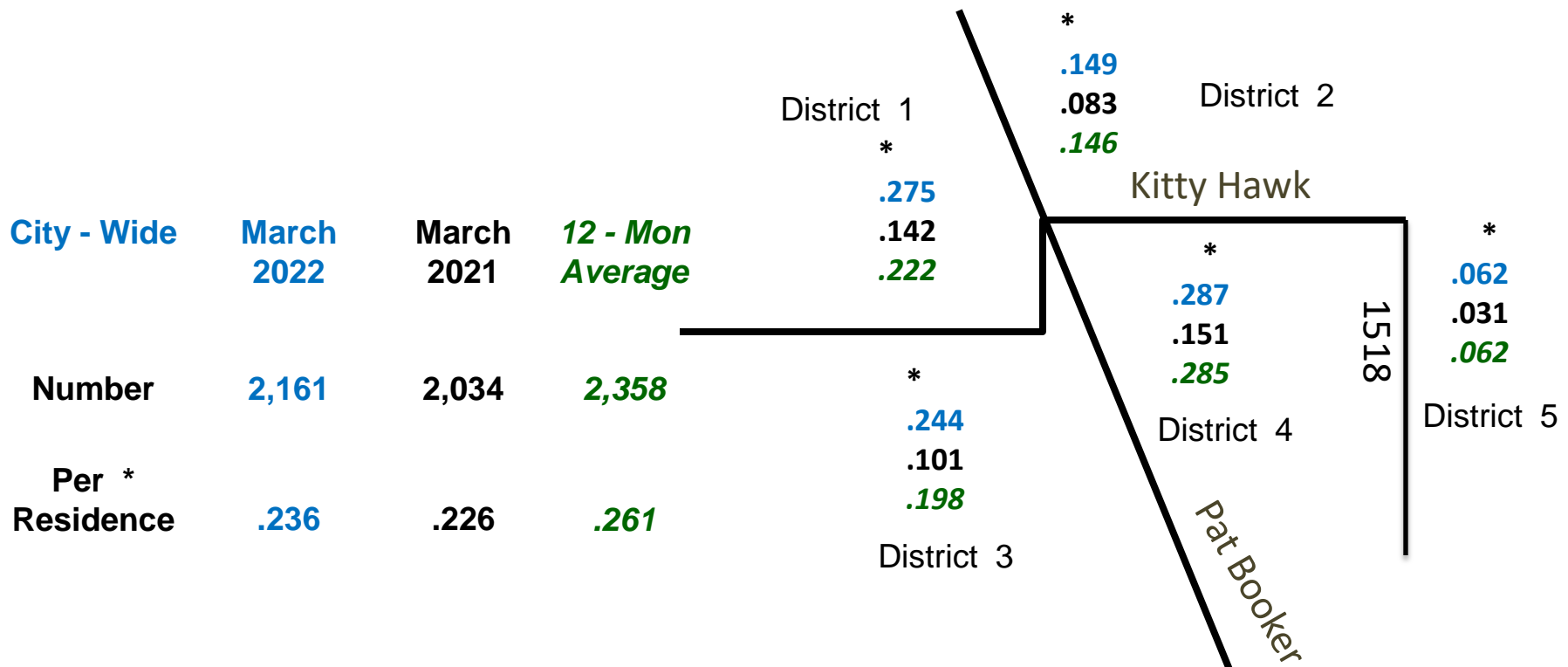
% by District
