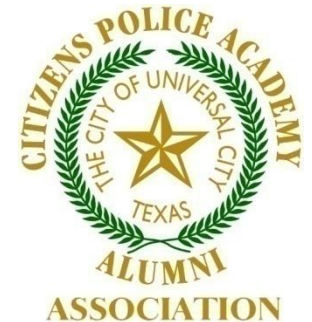

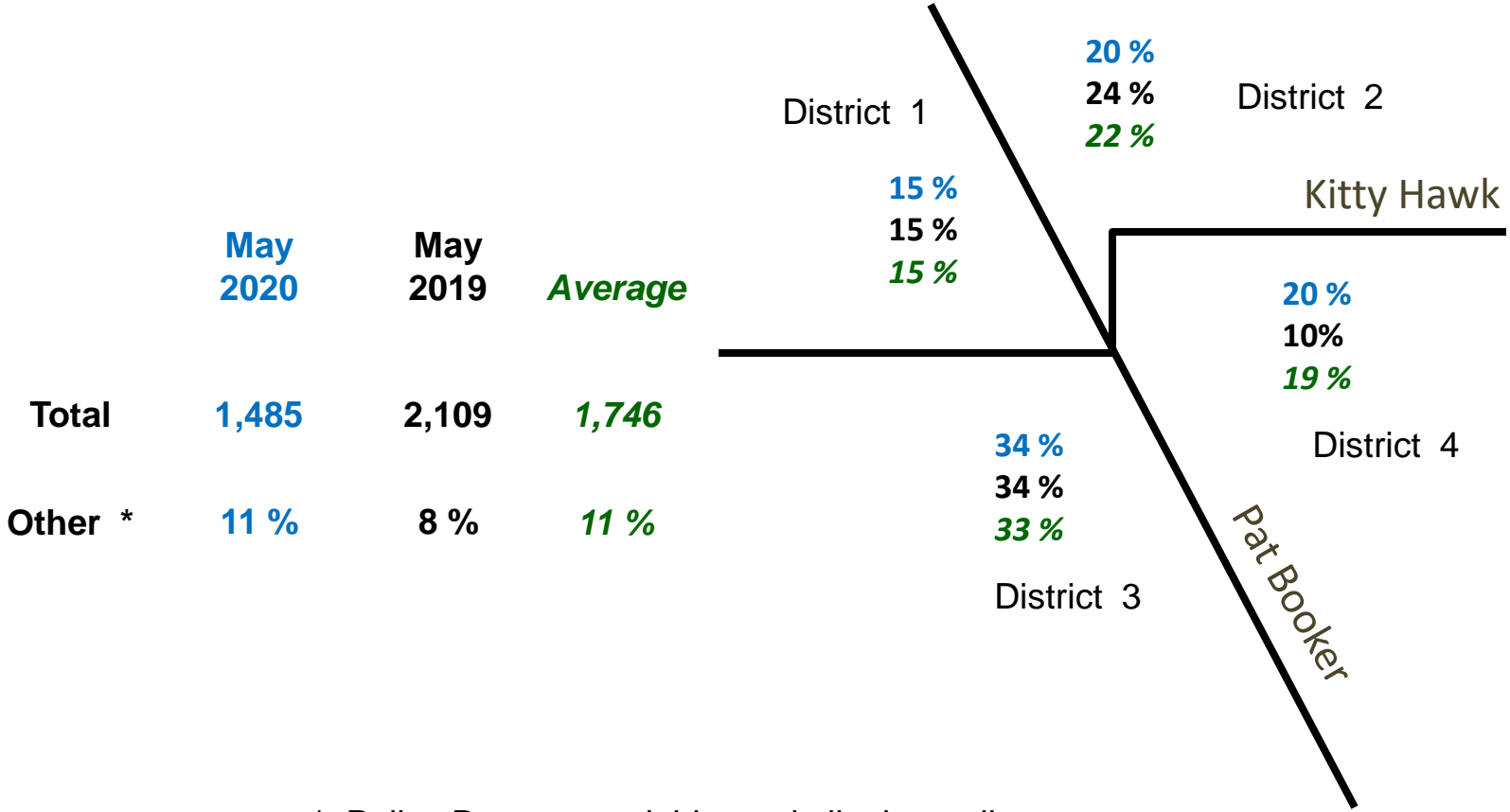

% by District

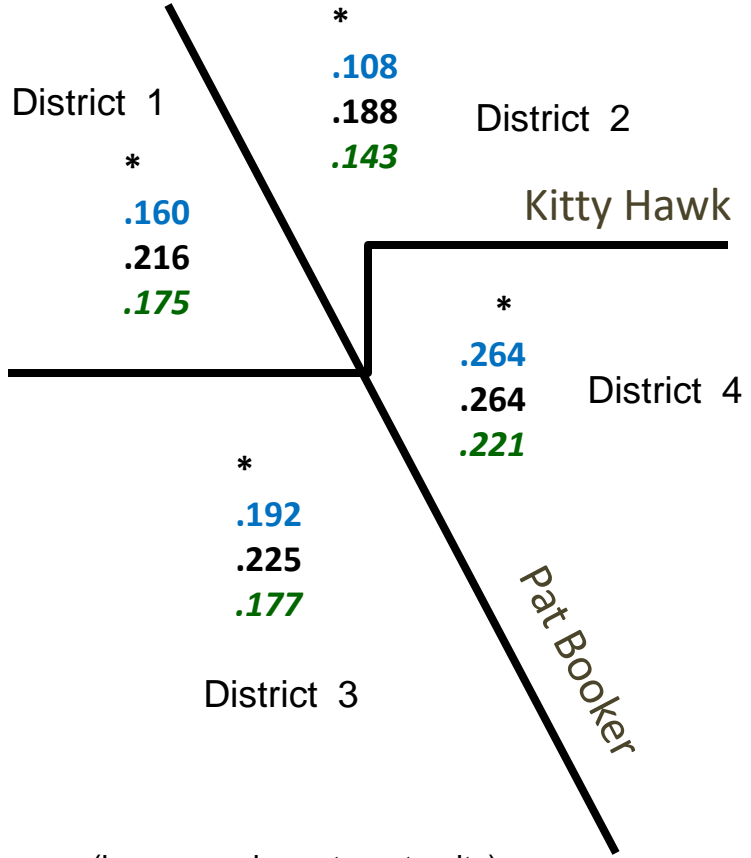
