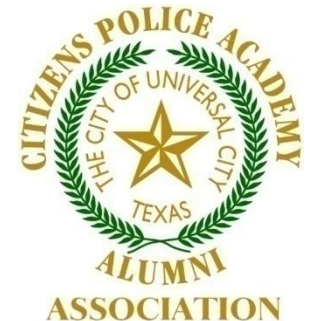


Crime Statistics Report

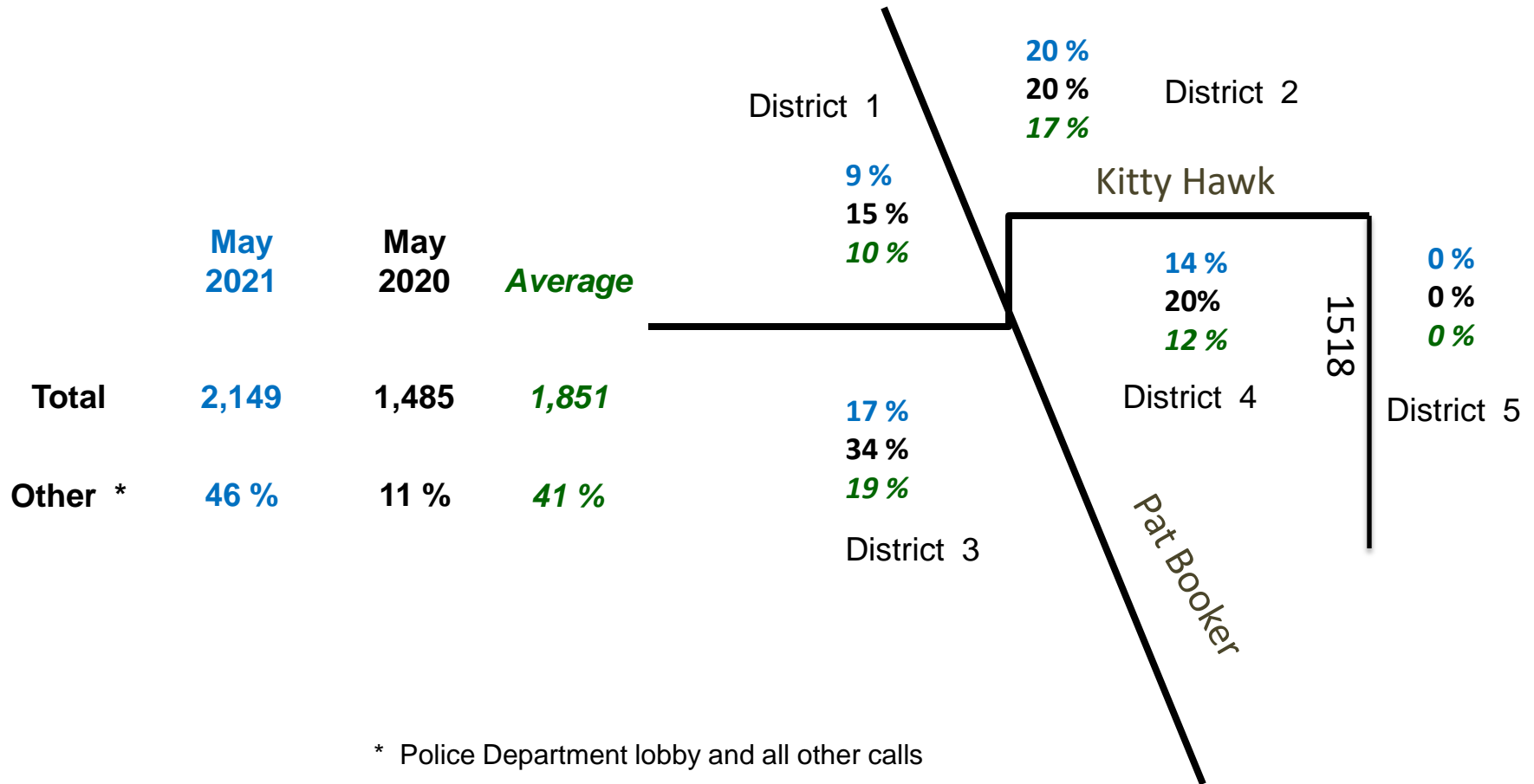

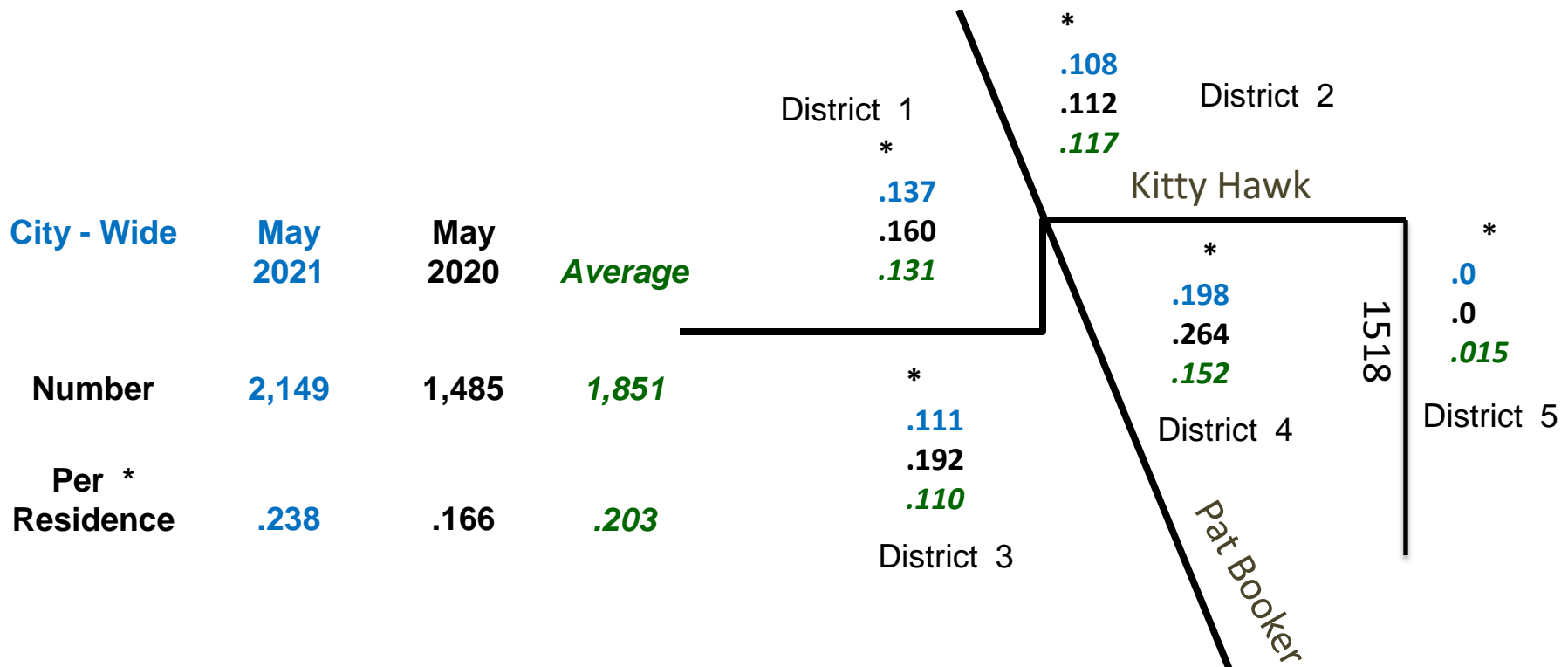
% by District
