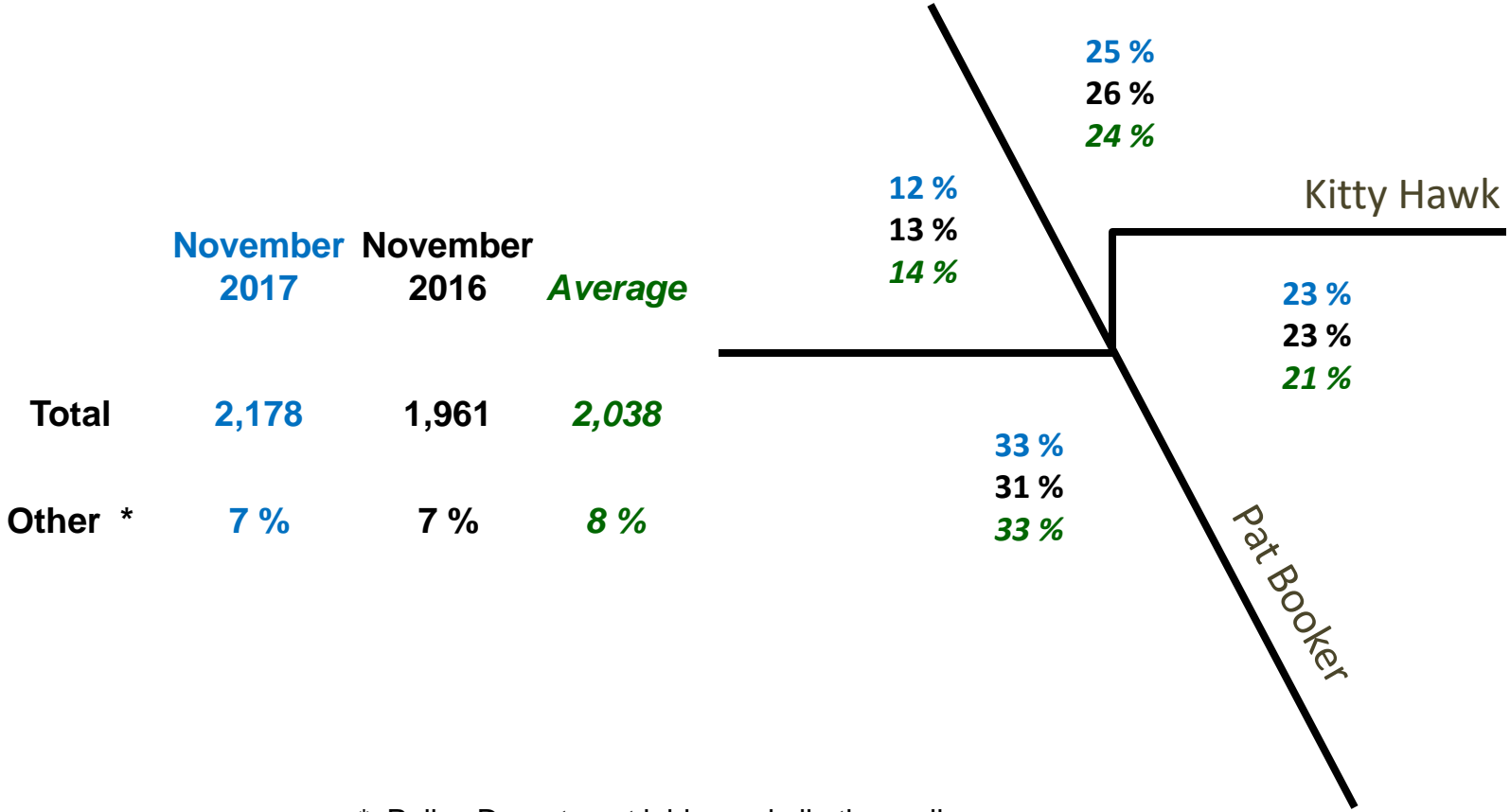

# Dispatches

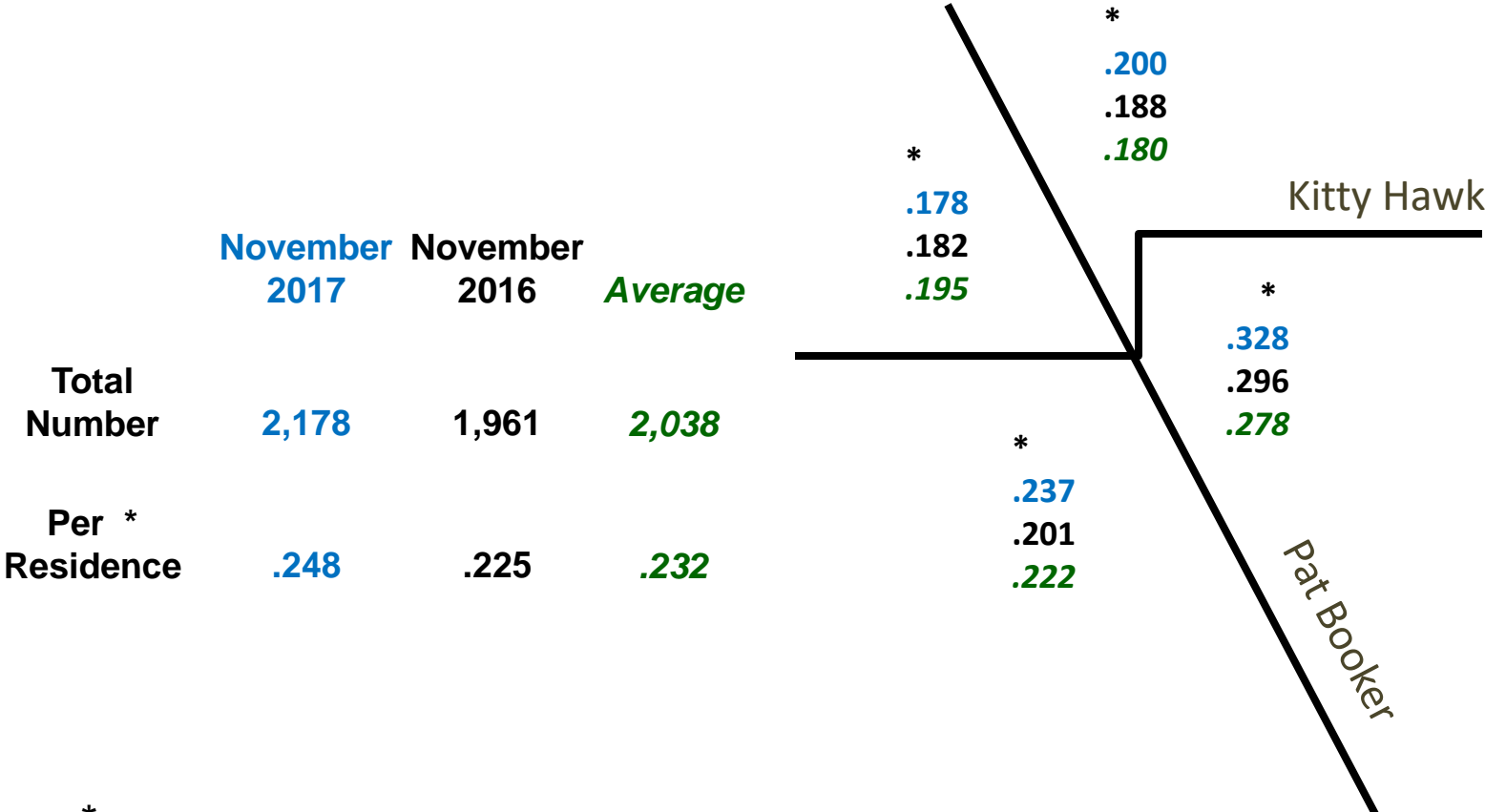
% by District
