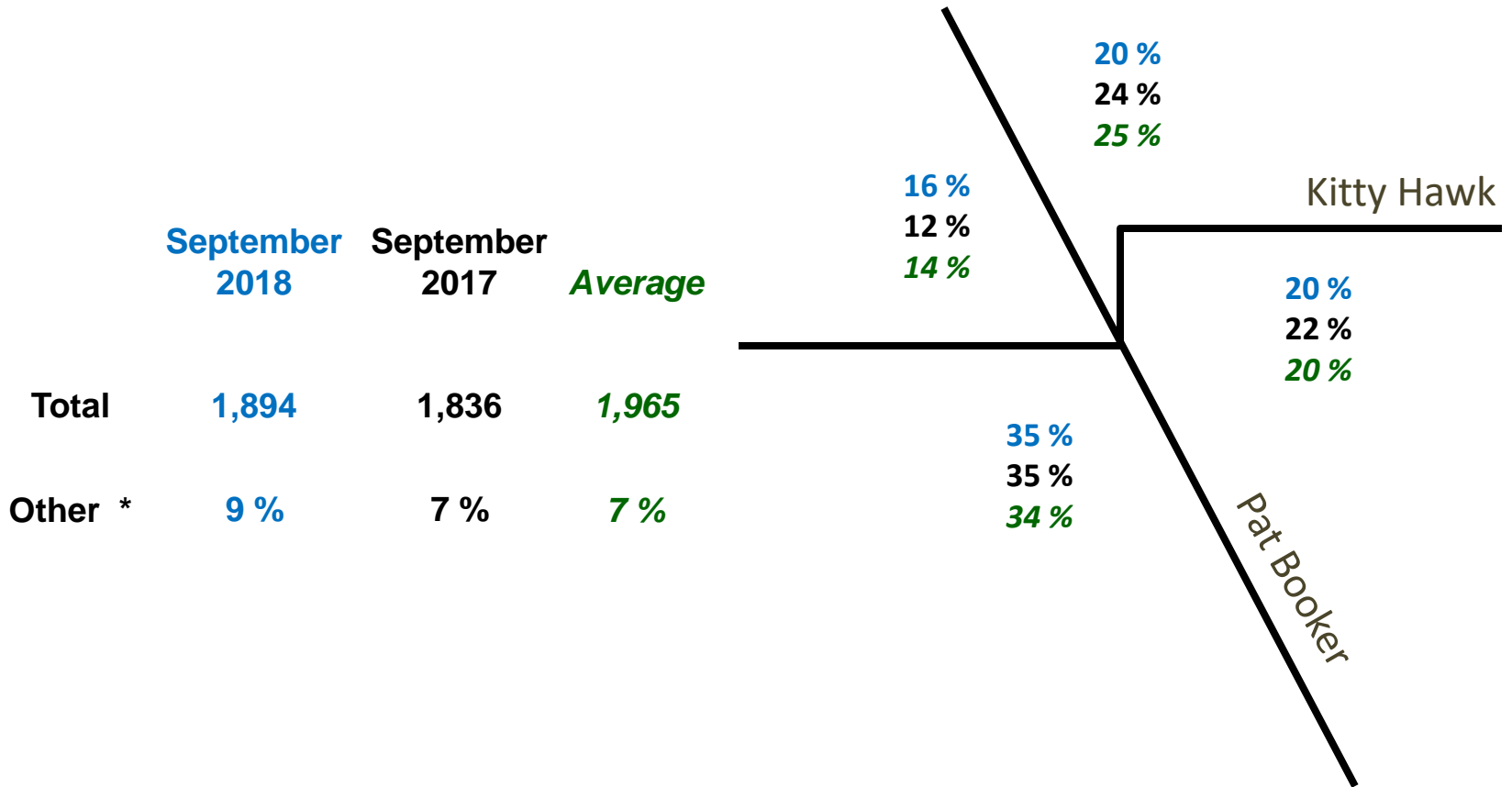

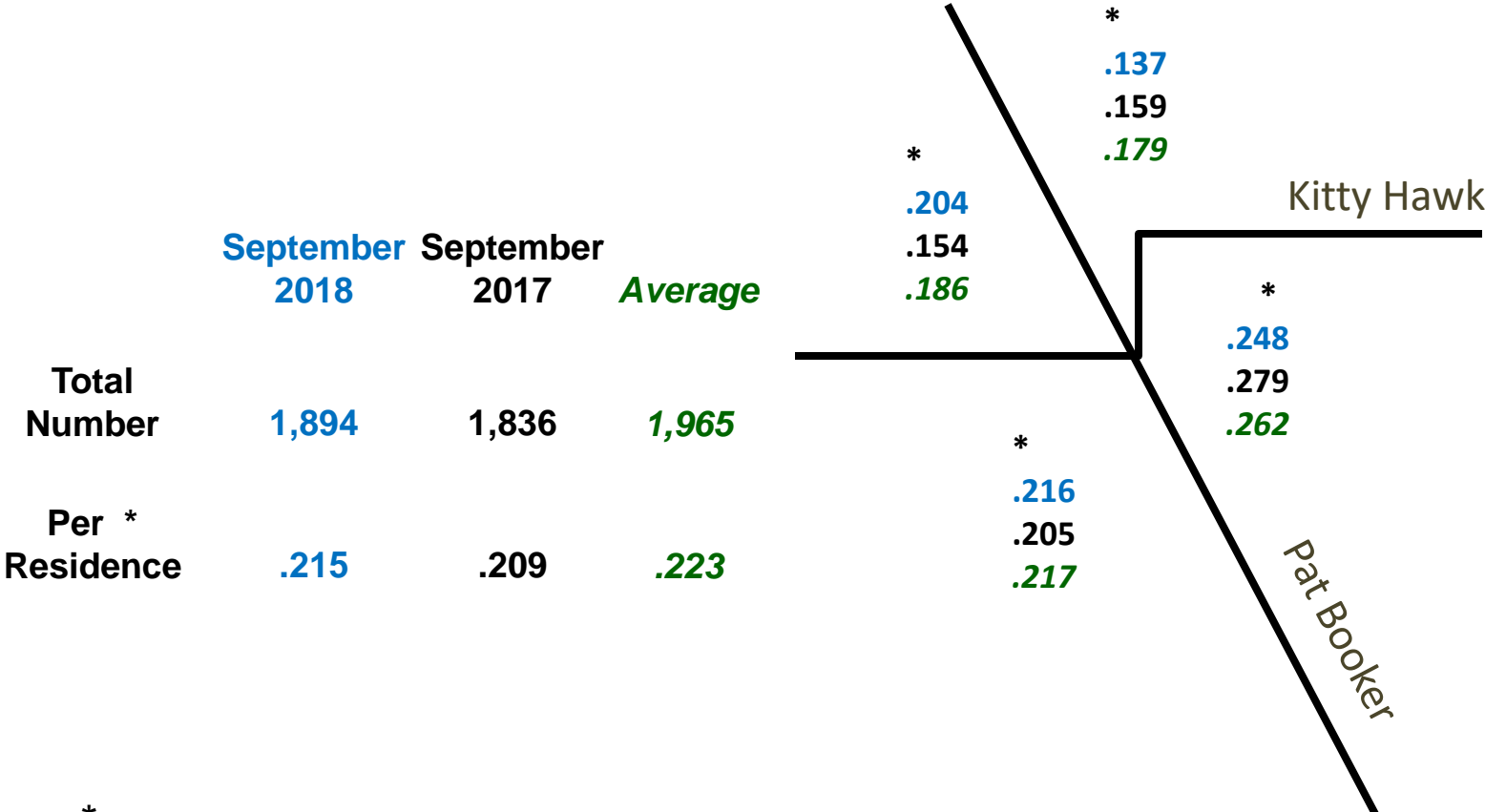
% by District

Do not allow accumulated mail and newspapers or an unkept yard to indicate you are not at home.
